## Purpose of the Job

Maintain same operational competencies as a Firefighter with the additional requirement to provide support to the management of the watch.

## Main Areas of Responsibility

<b>Take responsibility for effective performance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take responsibility for personal performance</li> <li>• Establish and maintain effective working relationships with people</li> <li>• Develop your own skills to improve performance</li> </ul>
<b>Save and preserve endangered life</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conduct a search to locate life involved in incidents</li> <li>• Rescue life involved in incidents</li> <li>• Provide treatment to casualties</li> <li>• Support people involved in rescue operations</li> </ul>
<b>Implement action as incident commander to resolve operational incidents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take charge of small incidents</li> <li>• Control and extinguish fires</li> <li>• Resolve incidents other than those involving fire or hazardous materials</li> <li>• Support people involved in an operational incident</li> <li>• Debrief personnel to review and learn from the incident</li> </ul>
<b>Protect the environment from the effects of hazardous materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mitigate damage to the environment from hazardous materials</li> <li>• Decontaminate people and property affected by hazardous materials</li> <li>• Support people involved in hazardous materials incidents</li> </ul>
<b>Support the effectiveness of operational response</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collect information on risks in your community</li> <li>• Collect information on resources in your community</li> <li>• Maintain internal resources</li> </ul>

<b>Support the development of colleagues in the workplace</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Communicate your own skills and knowledge to colleagues</li> <li>• Support development of colleagues</li> </ul>
<b>Deliver training and assessments to improve and measure performance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Present information to watch members</li> <li>• Organise and implement practical activities to aid learning</li> <li>• Measure the performance of watch members</li> </ul>
<b>Provide support role to Watch Manager</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Carry out administration tasks</li> <li>• Lead a small team of Firefighters when carrying out specific tasks or take charge of small incidents</li> </ul>
